

# WHITE WINES

## RIESLING

### **Latah Creek Riesling** \$8.99

This Riesling is full of wonderful Washington State Riesling fruit characters — apples, pears, spices of clove. This wine finishes crisp and clean on the palate. The wine is slightly sweet with balanced acidity.

### **Eroica Riesling** \$20.99

“The 2010 Eroica Riesling exudes mandarin orange and sweet lime aromas and flavors with subtle mineral notes. The mouth-watering acidity is beautifully balanced by flavorful Washington Riesling fruit. After a more than a decade we have truly found our “Eroica style,” striving for beautiful bright fruit with crisp acidity and enhanced minerality.” This wine receives consistent scores of 90pts and above from virtually every wine publication, and has been on the Wine Spectator’s Top 100 Wines of the World numerous times.

## PINOT GRIS

### **Duck Pond Pinot Gris** \$10.49

Made from grapes grown in Oregon’s famed Willamette Valley, this wine has aromas of peach, vanilla, and lime with an opulent mouth feel and gorgeous fresh-fruit.

### **Mercer Estates Pinot Gris** \$15.74

Our 2009 vintage yields fresh melon and peach aromas and flavors enhanced by herb and orange peel components, a rich mouth-feel and great acidity. This fruit driven wine was made in the vineyard with grapes picked as they moved from slightly under-ripe to ripe; much like picking a peach as it transforms from delicate peach flavors to riper, richer, more complex flavors. The result is a sophisticated, refreshing, mouth-watering Northwest version of the Alsatian classic

## SAUVIGNON BLANC

### **Matua Sauvignon Blanc** \$12.59

Soft in color with green hues, this Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc shows tropical and citrus fruits along with attractive herbaceous/variety characters on the nose. The palate is generous and fruit driven with classical Marlborough acidity giving a fresh, clean palate and passion fruit finish.

## VIOGNIER

### **Maryhill Viognier** \$12.59

This Rhone varietal, traditionally a blending grape, has found a foothold the world over and has become our best selling white for 9 years in a row. Aromas of pear, honeysuckle, mock orange, vanilla and hints of citrus entice you to find out why. Once you sip, the reason for its popularity becomes clear as the palate expresses white peach, bits of marzipan and lemon chiffon. This top seller is the perfect “Happy Hour” wine.

## CHARDONNAY

### **14 Hands Chardonnay** \$9.83

Bright apple and floral aromas are complemented by light notes of vanilla and sweet butterscotch. Juicy pear and apple flavors give way to subtle touches of toast and spice and ends with a soft finish.

### **Kendall Jackson Vintner’s Reserve Chardonnay** \$14.13

Citrus-kissed flavors such as mango, papaya and pineapple explode on the palate. Aromas of vanilla and honey intertwine to create depth and balance throughout.

### **L’ecole #41 Chardonnay** \$19.94

This beautifully expressive Chardonnay offers an enticing mix of tropical fruit, fresh apple, and characters of flint and slate. The vibrant structure of this wine is finely balanced between richness and minerality adding complexity on the clean, lingering finish.

## ZINFANDEL / ROSE

### **Beringer White Zinfandel** \$5.84

In making Beringer’s White Zinfandel, the focus is to highlight the fresh red berry, citrus and melon aromas and flavors, and round them out with subtle hints of nutmeg and clove. The wine has a youthful exuberance that is enjoyable as a sipper on its own, or with a variety of dishes.

### **Maryhill Rose of Sangiovese** \$10.49

Our 2010 Rosé of Sangiovese is a crisp refreshing sipper. The subtle bouquet has sweet and tart strawberry components to pique your curiosity. On the palate imagine hints of strawberry, cranberry and tart cherry with essence of pink grapefruit on the finish. This palate pleaser will pair well with picnic fare as well as leave you refreshed while relaxing on the veranda.

# RED WINES

## PINOT NOIR

### Primarius Pinot Noir \$15.74

A wonderfully aromatic Pinot Noir with raspberry, rhubarb, clove, vanilla and tomato leaf. Developed strawberry and rhubarb flavors are integrated on the palate. The finish leaves soft tannins and balanced acidity to carry the lingering fruit.

### Taz Fiddlestix Vineyard Pinot Noir \$35.99

The 2007 Fiddlestix Pinot Noir shines with its characteristic depth and complexity. The nose opens with layered aromas of brambles, blueberry, black plum, vanilla and baking spices. The palate is well-structured with notes of cherry compote, anise, cardamom and a hint of earthiness.

## MERLOT

### 14 Hands Merlot \$9.83

14 Hands Merlot offers classic Washington aromas of blackberries, plums and black cherries. Expressive flavors of berries and cherries are joined by subtle nuances of mocha and spice. While soft and approachable, this wine maintains a firm backbone of tannins.

### Northstar Columbia Valley Merlot \$39.99

Epitomizing power and finesse, our Columbia Valley Merlot is crafted from the finest grapes grown throughout the Columbia Valley AVA of eastern Washington State. Well balanced with a nose and flavors of raspberry, plum, and cherry, leading into notes of vanilla, coconut, and spice on the palate. Lots of structure and balanced tannins make this a great wine to pair with food.

## MALBEC

### Layer Cake Malbec \$16.79

Pure, rich and very elegant; a powerhouse of lush black fruit, silky cocoa, black spice and cream, wrapped around blackberry, cherry and ripe plum. Layered and complex with a nose to linger over, a finish that never ends. Sweet anise, hints of tobacco, black chocolate, more cherries and exotic spices, layers of jam.

### Pend d' Orielle Wood River Malbec \$27.29

Aromas of lilac and rose petals set the stage for flavors of bright plums steadied by beechnut and sandalwood. Just a touch of white pepper and raspberries finish off this classic Idaho Malbec. Enjoy with lamb, duck, smoked meats and cheeses.

## SHIRAZ/SYRAH

### Penfold's Bin 2 Shiraz/Mourvedre \$15.74

A solid, straightforward wine with aromas of satsuma plum and dark cherry set against a spicy nutmeg and savoury backdrop. Although youthful, the wine already shows the characteristic Bin 2 earthiness. A medium bodied wine, with softened, fine tannins.

### Amavi Syrah \$27.75

Aromas of dark fruits, mixed berries and violets complement a light earthiness, reminiscent of dusty gravel. Flavors of blackberries, raspberries and fig weave together with nuances of cream of cassis, spiced game and citrus. Remarkable structure and balance lead to a lingering finish.

## ZINFANDEL

### Maryhill Zinfandel \$17.84

Dallas Morning News gold medal winner! With easy comforting aromas of dark cherry pie this 2008 Zinfandel is inviting. On the palate, the cherries are joined by bittersweet chocolate, light raspberry and coffee. As the wine opens, darker flavors are revealed with oak and toffee and a bit more tannin grip showing up. The finish is easy and makes this wine highly quaffable

## VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO

### Zenato Amarone \$76.64

Amarone, the small jewel in our product line, is rightly considered the king of Verona's wines, produced from the best grapes of the Valpolicella Classic area, carefully selected and dried in trays until January. Showing deep ruby red, it releases intense aromas laden with rich spice and dried fruit; in the mouth it is a wine of superb richness and majestic flavors.

## CHIANTI

### Antinore Marchese Chianti Classico Riserva \$35.16

This wine has an intense ruby red color and an aroma characterized by very fruity notes; the conditions during the harvest produced grapes which were able to greatly express their varietal typicity, making the sangiovese very straightforward, rich, and characterized by the intensity of the grapes. The cabernet was able to express all of its strength together with elegance and refinement. On the palate, the wine opens very compactly, with hints of vanilla and chocolate, and with gentle tannins resulting from careful wood aging. The wine is minerally and has a persistent finish. It shows a great potential for extended longevity in the bottle.

## RED BLENDS

### 14 Hands Hot to Trot Red \$11.01

This Washington state red blend opens with generous aromas of crème de cassis and sweet blackberries. Fleshy, dark fruit flavors are joined by notes of wild huckleberries and a subtle pie crust nuance. Balanced by soft and velvety tannins, this smooth, easy drinking wine finishes with hints of toast and mocha.

### Desert Wind Ruah Meritage \$15.74

Crafted from fruit grown on Eastern Washington's Wahluke Slope, the Desert Wind Ruah is an affirmation of the area's viticultural prowess. Our full bodied, Bordeaux-inspired blend is enveloped in a lush core of concentrated blackberry fruit with a hint of anise on the palate. The wine has hints of toasted oak and spice and a rich garnet color, which is complemented by soft, velvety tannins and a lingering finish.

### Col Solare Shining Hill Red \$44.99

"Aromas of currants, boysenberry, cherry, clove and spice with a supple texture, soft finish, and lingering flavors of black fruit and spice characterize this 2008 bottling of Shining Hill."

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### 14 Hands Cabernet Sauvignon \$9.83

Subtle flavors of boysenberry, pie crust and allspice, surrounding a bright cherry core, are supported by a framework of supple tannins and culminate with a lengthy, lush finish.

### Mercer Estates Dead Canyon Ranch \$14.69

Individual vineyard lots were fermented, pressed off then barrel-aged separately for 18 months in American and French oak barrels. Cassis, cherry, forest-floor, and barrel toast contribute to the aroma of our 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon, followed by flavors of ripe cherry and bramble. The palates complex mouthfeel expresses ripe red berry fruit mingled with earth and spice, balanced acidity, and smooth tannins.

### Nelm's Road Cabernet Sauvignon \$23.09

Great aromas of cedar spice and black cherries, plenty of body and berry fruit on the palate, with a soft and approachable middle. Highly recommended value Cabernet one of Washington

### Beringer Knight's Valley Cabernet Sauvignon \$25.19

The 2007 Knights Valley is redolent of blackberry, brown sugar and star anise in the nose. Its juicy fruit core, round mouthfeel and dusty tannins are perfectly expressive of the Knights Valley vineyard. "Firm, intense and concentrated, with spicy, loamy earth, dried berry, sage and herbal scents. Full-bodied, ending with chewy tannins and a dash of black licorice.

### Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Artemis Vineyard \$53.99

Deep garnet in color, the 2008 ARTEMIS Cabernet Sauvignon offers black cherry and cassis tones and a velvety texture to the tannins. The wine delivers great depth and fruit concentration without heaviness on the palate. The incredible combination of vineyards in this blend shows the Stag's Leap Wine Cellars signature style of balance, elegance and restraint. The bright fruit, firm structure and balanced acidity allow this wine to pair well with food
